

Sign-up and/or log in to Docket® with email, Apple, or Google

Getting Started: Download the free mobile app by searching “Docket” in the Apple App Store or Google Play Store, or access app.dockethealth.com using your desktop or mobile browser.

1. Sign-up or log in.

Enter your email address and tap “Sign-up or Log In” to receive a sign-in link. You can also access Docket® by selecting the Apple or Google button.

2. Check your spelling.

Be sure to confirm that your email address was spelled correctly. Then, check your email inbox on your phone for a Docket® account confirmation email.

3. Confirm your email.

Select the “Confirm Email” button in the email titled, “Sign-up for Docket®” to proceed. Check your Junk folder if you do not see your email after 5 minutes.

Note: You must confirm your email using the same device you used to create your Docket® account.

4. Add account info.

Enter your first name, last name, date of birth, and legal sex to complete your account. Enter your mobile phone number to receive random 6-digit verification code, which will appear in your phone’s dialpad. Lastly, consent to the informational disclosure before searching for your immunization record(s).

Note: Creating an account will not guarantee you will be able to locate your record(s). Your name, date of birth, and legal sex entered in Docket® must match your record on file with your public health department’s registry (also known as an immunization information system, or “IIS”). In addition, your IIS record must contain a valid phone number or email.
